

With the implementation of the Central Electronic System of Payment Information (CESOP), reporting obligations are being introduced for the first time on an individual transaction basis for certain cross-border payments. From 1 January 2024, all EU institutions will be required to report to the respective tax authorities.

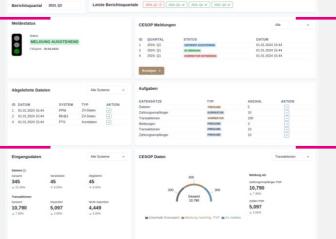
